The only other known Cotgroves at this time were William & Mary neè Midleton.

They have not been found in the 1841 Census. William would be about 60-66 and was known to have died in 1847. Mary was about 62; she died in 1875.

Also missing from both this Census and the 1851 returns is James Daniel Cotgrove, their son, born 1815 and died Leigh 1857
