

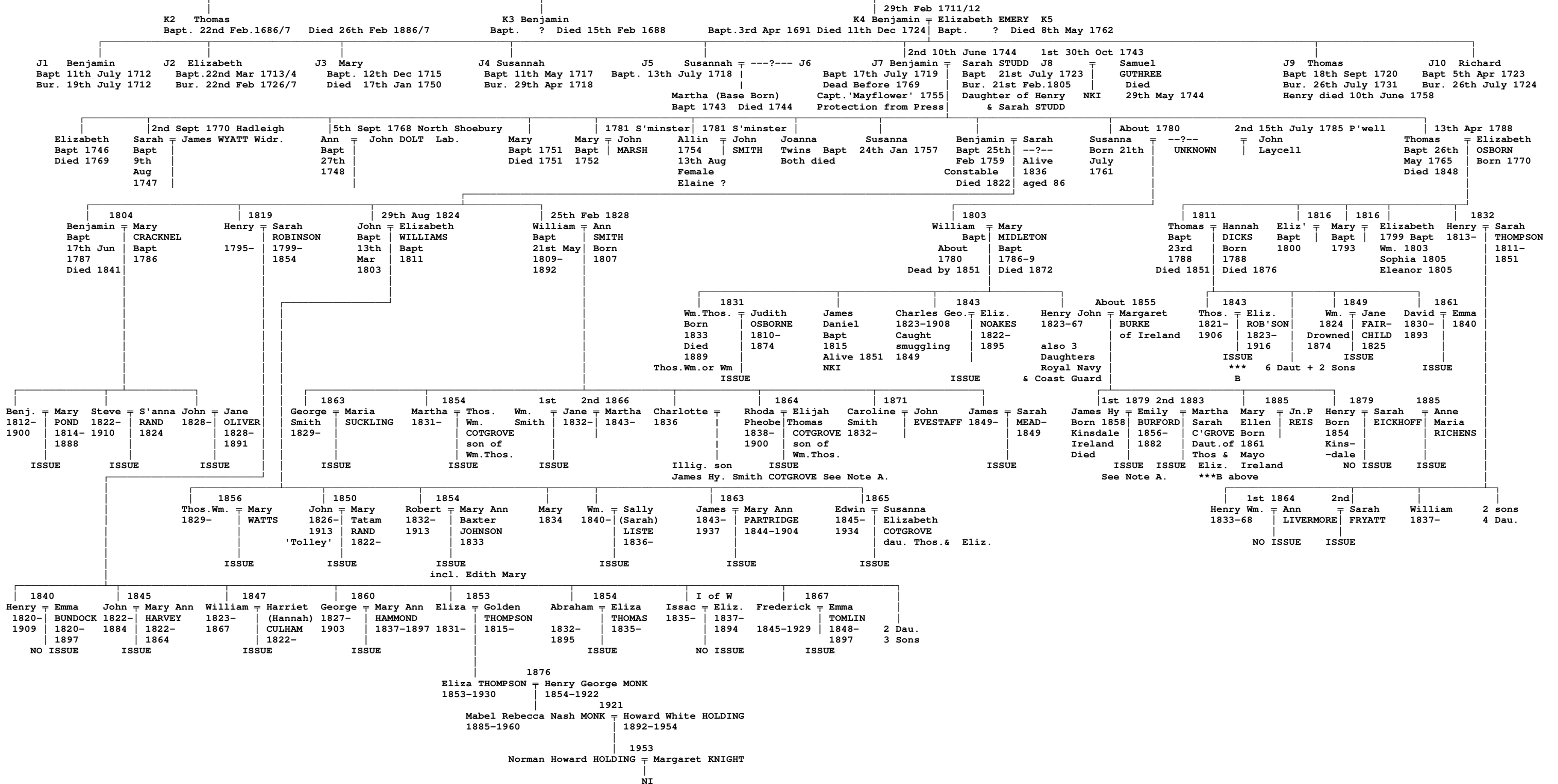

THE COTGROVE FAMILY OF LEIGH

The Story up to about 1850

After the first four generations some daughters and sons without issue have been omitted.

Father of Benjamin reputed to be Crewdeon COTGROVE, a Dutchman. As reported by Chris Cotgrove C110.

NOTE A. THERE ARE TWO JAMES HENRY COTGROVE'S. BOTH OF THE SAME DATE OF BIRTH. IT IS NOT YET POSSIBLE TO SAY WHICH ONE MARRIED EMILY BURFORD. THE OTHER DIED WITHOUT MARRYING.

The Cotgroves of Leigh

All the above were born in Leigh or in the neighbouring parishes, except for the children of Henry John COTGROVE (see bottom right) who were born in Ireland. The 26 married couples in the 1850's produced numerous offspring so that in order to show the following three or four generations a chart about 20-25 times as wide is needed. In 1988 about 350 persons carried the name COTGROVE
